President's Corner



KARI HOYT WINS PRESIDENT'S RACE OVERALL.


Trailsweepers captured the Stanley Sharaga Memorial President's Race (SSMPR) trophy last Saturday March 23 at Hunter. Ramapo, the second place team had more skiers, but wasn't able to find enough SSMPR division points in the three men's and three women's divisions.

Kari Hoyt had the highest NASTAR team point score of both men and women, winning the women's A division. Dale Ziegenfelder placed second overall and won the men's A division.

NASTAR team points are calculated based on a person's NASTAR handicap and their age as a way to level the playing field for older skiers. The mens and womens overall results were determined by the racers' team points, then split into 3 even divisions, and SSMPR points were given in order by a skier's place in his/her division.

Jeff Viglielmo, recovering from an injury, wasn't able to go full throttle but came in winning men's B division. Mo Viglielmo on the other hand skied too fast and missed winning women's B, taking last place in women's A. Sandy Schwinzer placed second in women's B, Diana Ziegenfelder placed third in women's C. David Wise captured third place in men's A with with the fifth highest overall team point score.

Here is the TSSC team score. The top 3 women's SSMPR points and top 4 men's counted toward the club's total. Ramapo had 195 points.
