INFORMATIONAL PROGRAMS

On Tuesday November 21, 2023 Zach Fletcher, gym owner and full-time sports coach delivered a program entitled "Optimizing Enjoyment for Older Athletes". He discussed and demonstrated a blend of need-to-know stretches and strengthening exercises providing expert advice, and practical tips all aimed at mitigating injury risk and maximizing enjoyment on the slopes and beyond. Attendance was on the low side given the weather and proximity to the Thanksgiving holiday, but everyone present enjoyed the Program, which was a team effort by Zach, son Luca and "grandpa" Rob.

Dale Ziegenfelder will deliver a program on **proper boot alignment**. Adjusting your boots for differences in your lower body is important for getting your skis flat on the snow when you are in a neutral athletic position.

For interested members, Dale will check your alignment in ski boots and depending on certain factors may be able to make some adjustment as necessary. To participate, bring your boots, their adjustment tools if appropriate and wear shorts if practical.

Tuesday January 23 2024, 7:00 pm

Gio Holmquist, General Manager and Head Boot Fitter at The Pro Ski and Ride in Hunter, NY will present a program on "Advanced Ski Tuning". He will discuss how regular ski and snowboard maintenance can enhance your on-snow experience as well as extend the life of your equipment. Gio will discuss capabilities of automated tuning machines such as variable edge bevels and custom base structures.

Gio grew up in the ski shop with his father operating The Pro until Gio took over operations in 2022. In addition to formal business education at The University at Albany and The College of Saint Rose, Gio regularly attends industry specific trainings such as Masterfit University and BootDoc academy.
